

Presentation:

Prenatal capsule: Each capsule contains -Carbonyl Iron INN 51 mg, Folic Acid BP 0.5 mg and Zinc USP 61.8 mg.

Descriptions:

Prenatal is a special preparation of Carbonyl Iron, Folic Acid and Zinc.

Indications:

Prenatal is indicated for the treatment and prophylaxis of Iron, Folic Acid and Zinc deficiency. It is indicated for use in improving the nutritional status of women prior to conception, throughout pregnancy, and in the postnatal period for both lactating and nonlactating mothers.

Dosage & Administration:

One capsule daily. In more severe cases, 2 capsules a day may be required or as directed by the physician.

Side Effects:

Generally well tolerated. However, a few allergic reactions may be seen.

Precautions:

Care should be taken in patients who may develop iron overload, such as those with haemochromatosis, haemolytic anemia or red cell aplasia. Iron chelates with tetracycline and absorption may be impaired.

Contraindications:

This product is contraindicated in patients with a known hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients.

Use in Pregnancy & Lactation :

Recommended.

Drug Interaction:

No such drug interactions have been reported.

Storage :

Store in a dry place below 25°C. Protect from light.

Prenatal capsule: Each box contains 3x10 capsules in blister pack.
